## Part 2 – Research Paper

You will write a 4-5 page formal research paper on your topic.

At a minimum you must address each of the following:

- 1. Identification of the problem/issue
- 2. Explanation of its significance
- 3. History of the development of the issue
- 4. Major points involved
- 5. Resolution/future

A list of at least 5 sources of information regarding your topic is due by **Friday, October <u>18<sup>th</sup></u>**. (You are welcome to read background information from sources such as Wikipedia, but Wikipedia cannot be counted as one of your 5 resources.)

Your final paper must be typed in size 12 font, double spaced, including parenthetical citations. It is due on <u>**Tuesday November 12th**</u>.
